



Cathcart Castle Golf Club – Social Membership

Social Associate membership is:

- a) Available to males and females.
- b) Has full access to the clubhouse.
- c) Whilst no entry fee is payable for this category, any transfer to another playing category, will incur the payment of an entry fee, if applicable at the time.
- d) Where Associates have transferred from playing membership and entry fee is paid in full, have an equity share of the Club equally with all other Full Members, but are not eligible to vote on Club matters.
- e) Has access to the course on payment of half of an external visitor's fee but subject to a fair use policy, at the discretion of the CoM.
- f) The CoM determines the annual subscription of such membership.

All members and associates are bound by the constitution and schedules of Cathcart Castle Golf Club

Membership of the Club consists of "Members" and "Associates". Only Members who have paid an entrance fee are entitled to vote on Club matters and have an equity share equally with all Full Members. Only Full Members have a vote in Club affairs, and only Full Members are allowed to hold office in the Council of Management (CoM) and the Captain's Committee (CC). Only a person who has been a Full Member for at least three years may propose or second an application for membership.

All Members and Associates must keep their contact details up to date, by either updating them online, on the Club's membership system, or by notifying them to the Managing Secretary. Where notification of contact detail changes has not been made, all notices sent to old contact details will be deemed to be duly delivered.

A Member or Associate who wishes to resign from the Club must give written notice to the Managing Secretary before October 1. If the notice of resignation is not received by the Managing Secretary within seven days after the AGM in that same year, the Member or Associate will be liable for the subscription fee charged pro rata from 1 October until date of resignation.

Members and Associates may seek to suspend or transfer the category of their Membership prior to the start of the membership year, and the decision on any such request, rests with the CoM. Successful applicants for suspension, will have no rights as a Member or Associate in any category. Members or Associates wishing to return from a suspension must apply to the Managing Secretary.
